

Portraiture, Greek Mythology and an Elegant Piece of French Laquer Furniture

At this summer's auction in Bredgade we are going on a bit of a journey through the history of Danish art. We begin in the 1700s with two glorious portraits by Jens Juel, who made it his primary purpose to paint representatives of society's elite. In this case it is portraits of the Supreme Court Justice Iver Rosenkrantz-Levetzau and his wife Juliane, who is featured on the cover of the catalogue, both are wearing wigs and clothing according to the fashion of the time (cat. no. 18). C.W. Eckersberg became the next century's most prominent Danish artist, and as many other Danish Golden Age painters he travelled south to find inspiration. At this auction we have two pictures from his stay in Paris during the years 1810-13. One portrays Antigone following her blind father Oedipus across a bridge, and in the second painting a young couple are disturbed, mid-seduction, by a snake (cat. no. 27 and 13). 18th century Danish art of an international quality is also represented by Thorald Læssøe's wonderful Roman motifs and Frederik Kraft's view of Tivoli in Rome (cat. no. 7, 8 and 15). From the year 1900 we can present fine landscapes by L.A. Ring, a sunlit scene from Ravello by Marie Krøyer and one of Copenhagen artist Paul Fischer's lively winter scenes from Amager Tory, with cigar merchant W.O. Larsen standing in front of his store (cat. no. 61-65, 39 and 60).

We also focus on art and antiques from Russia, just as Koldinghus Museum is currently doing with their exhibition "Fabergé – The Tsar's jeweller and the connections to the Danish royal family." Items from Fabergé have long been in the spotlight at our auctions, and this time we can present a beautiful silver frame with a photograph of Tsar Nicholas II and Tsaritsa Alexandra Feodorovna of Russia with the couple's firstborn on her lap (cat. no. 316). The ultimate Russian highlight is a silver bust of Tsaritsa Maria Feodorovna of Russia. It was made in 1877 by silver manufacturer Sasikov, who was purveyor to the Russian royal court and one of the most sought-after manufacturers in Moscow and St. Petersburg (cat. no. 312). Among the paintings we can present several fine works by the famous artist Nikolai Petrovich Bogdanoff-Belsky, including a painting from 1934 of a boy playing sitar for his friends in the sun (cat. no. 293).

In Europe during the 1700s the contemporary interest in Far Eastern culture also found its way into furniture design. At the auction, we have a Bureau en Pente from about 1750 with the finest Japanese lacquerwork. It has previously belonged to the French businessman, philanthropist and art collector Paul Louis Weiller. The furniture is attributed to the French cabinetmaker Jacques Dubois, who supplied furniture to many royal houses and noble families across Europe. As the furniture itself is evidence of, Dubois mastered the Louis XV-style completely and incorporated Japanese panels in his furniture, as contemporary fashion prescribed (cat. no. 395). Another noteworthy piece of furniture at the auction is a baroque cabinet with bronzes and exquisite paintings of mythological scenes (cat. no. 368).

An exotic clip shaped like a scarab made of diamonds, coral and turquoise from the famous jeweller Cartier and an exclusive English diamond bracelet is guaranteed to turn heads at the auction as well. They date from the 1930s and represent the style of Art Deco, which among other things focused on Egyptian culture and cubic forms (cat. no. 502 and 538). The gentlemen visiting the auction can look forward to a coveted Rolex Model GMT-Master "Gilt" from 1966, complete set. Up for auction is also an unusual Audemars Piguet Royal Oak Chronograph with a brown disc, as well many more elegant wristwatches (cat. no. 674 and 678).

Portrætkunst, græsk mytologi og et elegant fransk lakmøbel

På sommerens auktion i Bredgade tager vi på lidt af en rejse i ældre dansk kunst. Vi lægger ud med 1700-tallet og to ypperlige portrætter af Jens Juel, der gjorde det til sit primære virke at male repræsentanter fra samfundets elite. I dette tilfælde gælder det højesteretsassessor Iver Rosenkrantz-Levetzau og hustruen Juliane (vist på forsiden af kataloget) iført tidens moderigtige parykker ogbeklædning (kat.nr. 18). C.W. Eckersberg blev det næste århundredes fremmeste kunstner, og som mange af guldalderens malere søgte han mod syd for at hente inspiration. Med på auktionen har vi to motiver fra hans ophold i Paris i årene 1810-13. Det ene skildrer Antigone, der følger sin blinde far Ødipus over en bro, og i det andet bevæger et ungt par sig ud i forførelsens kunst, men forstyrres af en slange (kat.nr. 27 og 13). Anden dansk 1800-tals kunst af international kvalitet er repræsenteret med Thorald Læssøes herlige romerske motiver og Frederik Krafts utsigt mod Tivoli ved Rom (kat.nr. 7, 8 og 15). Fra årene omkring 1900 byder vi på fine landskabsmalerier af L.A. Ring, et solbeskinnet motiv fra Ravello af Marie Krøyer og et af københavnermaleren Paul Fischers livlige vinterskildringer fra Amagertorv med cigargrosserer W.Ø. Larsen stående foran sin forretning (kat.nr. 61-65, 39 og 60).

Vi sætter også fokus på kunst og antikviteter fra Rusland i lighed med Museet på Koldinghus og deres aktuelle udstilling "Fabergé – Zarens hofjuveler og forbindelsen til den danske kongefamilie". På vores auktioner har kunstgenstande fra Fabergé længe været i søgelyset, og denne gang præsenterer vi en smuk sølvramme herfra med et fotografi af Zar Nikolaj II og Zaritsa Alexandra Feodorovna af Rusland med parrets førstefødte i favnen (kat.nr. 316). Det ultimative russiske højdepunkt er en sølvbuste af Kejserinde Dagmar af Rusland fra 1877 af sølvfabrikanten Sasikov, der var hofleverandør og en af de mest eftertragtede i Moskva og Skt. Petersborg (kat.nr. 312). Blandt malerierne finder man flere fine arbejder af den berømte kunstner Nikolai Petrovich Bogdanoff-Belsky, heriblandt en skildring fra 1934 af en dreng, der spiller citar for sine kammerater i solen (kat.nr. 293).

I 1700-tallets Europa fandt tidens interesse for Østens kultur vej til møbelkunsten. Med på auktionen har vi et Bureau en Pente fra ca. 1750 med det fineste japanske lakarbejde og proveniens fra den franske forretningsmand, filantrop og kunstsamler Paul Louis Weiller. Møblet tilskrives den franske snedkermester Jacques Dubois, der leverede møbler til mange kongehuse og adelsfamilier i Europa. Som møblet vidner om, mestrede han til fulde Louis XV-stilen og inkorporerede japanske paneler i sine møbler, som tidens mode foreskrev (kat.nr. 395). Et andet bemærkelsesværdigt møbel er det barokke kabinetskab med bronzer og udsøgte malerier med mytologiske scener (kat.nr. 368).

En eksotisk klips formet som en skarabæ af diamant, koral og turkis fra den berømte juveler Cartier og et eksklusivt engelsk diamantarmbånd vil med garanti vække opmærksomhed på auktionen. De stammer fra 1930'erne og repræsenterer stilretningen art deco, der bl.a. havde fokus på ægyptisk kultur og kubiske former (kat.nr. 502 og 538). Herrerne kan denne gang se frem til et eftertragtet Rolex Model GMT-Master "Gilt" fra 1966, et komplet sæt erhvervet hos Knud Pedersen i Århus. Udbudt er også et usædvanligt Audemars Piguet Royal Oak Chronograph med brun skive, men der er naturligvis meget mere at vælge imellem blandt auktionens perlerække af armbåndsure (kat.nr. 674 og 678).

(Obvious Inclusions)

May be visible face-up without the use of magnification. In P3, they might affect the stone's durability.

COLOUR GRADING

Colour grading follows a scale describing the “whiteness” or absence of secondary colour in a white diamond. The D-to-Z scale begins with D (colourless) and continues through the alphabet to Z (light yellow). At the top of the scale the diamond will appear white, and at the bottom yellowish or brownish.

CONDITIONS OF PURCHASE

§ 1. BIDDING

The buyer shall be the highest bidder at the "hammer price". Any person bidding on behalf of a third party shall be liable in surety for completion of the sale.

At the request of Bruun Rasmussen Kunstauktioner (hereinafter called Bruun Rasmussen), all bidders, whether they wish to make bids in person at the place of auction or commission bids by letter, fax or the homepage direct telephone bids or the homepage, should be able to document their ability to pay and be able to provide proof of identity at any time. Bruun Rasmussen is entitled to refuse to accept a bid if, when requested, adequate security or adequate payment on account has not been rendered.

Bids should be made by the bidder in person at the place of auction or by written commission by letter, fax or the homepage. For online auctions all bids are submitted via the homepage. Telephone bidding is possible within certain conditions made out by Bruun Rasmussen. Bruun Rasmussen is not to be held responsible for any errors that may occur using this service. The auctioneer shall have absolute discretion as to the increment of the bids. The auctioneer will also make decisions in all cases of doubt regarding the bidding.

Credit/debit card information must be registered with Bruun Rasmussen before bids can be submitted.

§ 2. PAYMENT

Purchases made at all Bruun Rasmussen traditional salesroom auctions are subject to a 30% fee (for wines, coins and stamps 25%), which covers 24% buyer's premium plus VAT of the premium.

Purchases made at all Bruun Rasmussen online auctions are subject to a 25% fee, which covers 20% buyer's premium and VAT of the premium.

Certain lots are sold in accordance with specific rules on normal VAT arrangement (hereinafter called normal VAT), so that the purchase price is the hammer price plus an additional 24% (for online auctions, wines, coins and stamps 20%) in buyer's premium and VAT of 25% levied on both the hammer price and the buyer's premium. The lots subject to Full VAT are indicated as such in the catalogue and on the homepage with an asterisk (*).

Danish VAT registered buyers shall provide Bruun Rasmussen with documentation of their SE-/CVR -number (VAT No.) as this has to be quoted on the invoice for goods bought at full VAT.

For some foreign buyers, specific VAT-exemption rules apply (cf. Article 3). VAT-exemption does not apply to private buyers from the EU who are considered as Danish buyers (cf. current Danish legislation on Special VAT Scheme for Sales of Works of Art, Collectors' items and Antiques by Public Auction).

The purchase price falls due for payment when the goods have been knocked down. Payment may be made in cash up to DKK 50,000, by Dankort, banker's cheque, traveller's cheque, Visa-, Master-, Diners Club- or Eurocard. Personal foreign cheques may only be used for payment by prior arrangement.

At traditional auctions payment for purchased items must be made during or immediately after the auction. Under all circumstances payment must be made no later than eight days from the date of the invoice. With online auctions, payment automatically takes place when the items are prepared for dispatch (circa 12 hours after the purchase has been made) using the credit/debit card details submitted by the purchaser. At the same time an invoice and dispatch information will be sent to the purchaser.

Should the purchase price not be paid by the due date, interest at 1.5 % per new month will be charged.

If the purchase price and interest are not paid within eight days after Bruun Rasmussen has sent its demand to the buyer, Bruun Rasmussen shall be entitled to rescind the sale and resell the goods at a Bruun Rasmussen auction or privately, and to demand reimbursement of any related losses from the defaulting

buyer. Any further profit on the sale shall be payable to the person who had deposited the goods for sale by auction.

If the defaulting buyer is entitled to proceeds from a sale of goods by Bruun Rasmussen, Bruun Rasmussen shall be entitled to set off its receivables against its payables to the defaulting buyer.

If the defaulting buyer has deposited other goods for sale, Bruun Rasmussen shall be entitled to sell such goods at a Bruun Rasmussen auction without being bound by the reserve stipulated by the defaulting buyer. The defaulting buyer shall not be entitled to demand the surrender of goods deposited for sale as long as the debt payable to Bruun Rasmussen has not been discharged, regardless of whether the value of such goods may be deemed to exceed the debt payable.

Bruun Rasmussen shall be entitled to refuse a bid made by a buyer who is in default in respect to his payment obligations to Bruun Rasmussen, as well as a bid made by a third party on behalf of such a defaulting buyer. Bruun Rasmussen shall further be entitled to demand a deposit as a condition of accepting any future bids from such a purchaser.

§ 3. MONEY-BACK GUARANTEE

- A. Purchases made on all traditional salesroom auctions are unconditional and can not be cancelled regardless of the type of bid such as absentee web bid, live-bidding or otherwise.
- B. Online purchase of items by private individuals is subject to Danish consumer law, which extends 14 days of money-back guarantee. The purchaser is liable for any costs related to the transport of returned items.

Should a purchaser seek to avail himself or herself of the money-back guarantee, Bruun Rasmussen will refund the payment on receiving the returned items. Please note that the date on which accounts are debited is subject to the policy of the purchaser's bank/credit card company.

§ 4. EXEMPTION FROM VAT

Foreign buyers who meet the following conditions pay the applicable auction fees, cf. above, but are not charged Danish VAT. However, the Danish VAT must be deposited at Bruun Rasmussen until documentation has been provided to show that the goods have been exported as required by law.

- A. Buyers who are VAT-registered in another EU country are exempt from paying Danish VAT when it can be documented that the item purchased has been transported to the address declared by the buyer to Bruun Rasmussen and specified on the invoice. In such cases, VAT must be settled in accordance with the rules in force in the country where the company is VAT-registered. It is advisable to check with the relevant local authorities.
- B. Buyers domiciled outside the EU may be exempt from Danish VAT when it can be documented that the purchase has been transported out of the EU. As far as possible, Bruun Rasmussen issues the necessary export documents to be presented to the customs authorities, and reserves the right to charge a fee for doing so.

If the goods are being exported by a freight forwarder authorised by Bruun Rasmussen, the VAT need not be deposited. See the list of approved freight forwarders

§ 5. PAYMENT OF TAXES AND DUTIES

- A. VAT-registered businesses in other EU Member States may opt out of exercising the option of VAT exemption and instead pay Danish VAT on second-hand goods/full VAT. Bruun Rasmussen must be informed of this before 10 am on the day after the purchase.
- B. VAT-registered businesses in Denmark may choose to pay full VAT, cf. above. Bruun Rasmussen must be informed of this before 10 am on the day after the purchase.

§ 6. COLLECTION OF PURCHASES

The purchase price must be paid in full before the purchased lot can be passed over to the buyer. From the time of the lot being knocked down to the buyer, until its collection, the purchased lot will be held at the buyer's own expense and risk.

A storage fee will be charged for lots which have not been collected according to agreement. Lots which have been paid for but not collected will be storaged at buyers expense. Lots not collected within 1 year will be resold at auction or privately at the buyer's expense.

§ 7. DISPATCH

Should Bruun Rasmussen undertake the packaging and forwarding of purchased goods, this shall be done at the buyer's own expense and risk. Bruun Rasmussen shall thus not be held liable neither for any damage caused to purchased goods during dispatch nor for any missing consignments.

§ 8. DROIT DE SUITE

In accordance with Danish copyright law, an additional royalty fee is to be paid for the purchase of works by contemporary Danish artist and some international artists who are either still alive or who have been dead for less than 70 years. The additional royalty fee will be collected by Bruun Rasmussen on behalf of Copydan, which is a Danish-based joint collecting society. Such works are marked with (CD) for Copydan next to the lot number.

The Copydan royalty fee is added to the auction price including the buyer's premium when the total exceeds €300.

Copydan royalty fees:

- 5% of the auction price and buyer's premium (excluding VAT) totalling up to €50,000.
- 3% of the auction price and buyer's premium (excluding VAT) of totals between €50,000 and €200,000.
- 1% of the auction price and buyer's premium (excluding VAT) of totals between €200,000 and €350,000.
- 0.5% of the auction price and buyer's premium (excluding VAT) of totals between €350,000 and €500,000.
- 0.25% of the auction price and buyer's premium (excluding VAT) of totals above €500,000.

Copydan royalties must not exceed €12,500 for an individual artwork.

The euro exchange rate has been set by Copydan for 2016 at DKK 746,02 per €100.

§ 9. EXPORT LICENCE

Applications for an export licence must be made to the Danish Cultural Assets Committee when required in accordance with current Danish legislation on the protection and preservation of cultural assets in Denmark. Where such a licence has not been obtained, the foreign buyer will be informed thereof immediately after the lot has been knocked down to the buyer. Another application will subsequently be sent to the Danish Cultural Assets Committee by Bruun Rasmussen on behalf of the buyer, now that the price is known. Should an export licence not be granted, the Danish Cultural Assets Committee would be obliged to acquire the purchased lot at the purchase price, and the buyer would thus not be bound to the purchase.

§ 10. DESCRIPTION OF LOTS

All lots are sold in the condition in which they are found when knocked down and as described in the catalogue and on the homepage with subsequently published changes and modifications. VAT AND COPY-DAN INFORMATION

MOMS OG KUNSTNERAFGIFT

BUYER'S STANDARD PREMIUM

30% AUCTIONEERS' MARGIN SCHEME

As of 1 January 1995 new EC regulations came into effect regarding the sale of secondhand goods, works of art, collector's items and antiques; these items may now be traded under the Auctioneers' Margin Scheme.

Under the Auctioneers' Margin Scheme the premium only is subject to VAT, i.e. the hammer price is exempted from VAT. The buyer's premium of 25% will thus henceforth include non-refundable VAT.

FULL VAT *

will be charged on goods that cannot be traded under the Auctioneers' Margin Scheme. These lots are marked with an asterix *. The buyer pays the auction premium of 24% plus 25% VAT on the hammer price as well as the buyer's premium.

BUYER'S REDUCED PREMIUM 24%

is paid by buyers fulfilling the following terms/conditions:

1. Danish VAT registered buyers may choose to pay the 24% buyer's premium + 25% VAT on the total amount (Full VAT). The buyer may have the total VAT refunded and thus pays 24% in buyer's premium only.
2. VAT registered buyers in other EU countries may avoid Danish VAT by using their VAT registration number and thereby pay a buyer's premium of 24% only.
3. Residents of countries outside the EU meeting the Danish customs authorities' requirements regarding the export of goods pay the buyer's premium of 24% only (see Conditions of Purchase §3, Exemption from VAT).

ARTISTS' ROYALTIES PAYABLE TO COPY-DAN ^{CD}

Pursuant to current Danish legislation on copyright an artists' royalty of 5% of the total price exclusive of VAT (i.e. hammer price plus buyer's premium 24%) shall be collected on works of modern art by all Danish and most foreign artists. These works are marked ^{CD} for Copy-Dan next to the lot number.

30% - BRUGT MOMS

1. januar 1995 trådte nye love i kraft i EU vedrørende moms ved handel på auktion med brugte varer, kunstgenstande, samlerobjekter og antikviteter, der nu kan handles til brugt moms.

Efter de nye regler er det kun auktionsmokstninger, der skal tillægges moms, og ikke som tidligere varens fulde pris. I auktionsmokstninger er indregnet ikke fradragtsberettiget moms.

FULD MOMS *

anvendes for visse varer som ikke kan handles i brugt moms. Disse er mærket med en stjerne *. Købere skal betale 24% i auktionsmokstninger, hvortil lægges 25% moms af hammerslaget og auktionsmokstningerne.

REDUCEREDE AUKTIONSMOKSTNINGER 24%

betales af købere der opfylder følgende betingelser:

1. Danske momsregistrerede købere kan vælge at betale 24% i auktionsmokstninger + 25% moms af hele (fuldmoms). Momsbeløbet kan køber modregne, og betaler derved 24% i auktionsmokstninger.
2. Momsregistrerede købere i andre EU-lande kan, ved at anvende deres EU-momsnr., undgå den danske moms og derved betale 24% i auktionsmokstninger.
3. Alle købere med bopæl i et land uden for EU, der opfylder de danske toldmyndigheders krav i forbindelse med eksport, betaler derved 24% i auktionsmokstninger (se købskonditioner, §4, Afgiftsfritagelse).

KUNSTNERAFGIFT TIL COPY-DAN ^{CD}

I følge gældende dansk lovgivning om ophavsret, skal der opkræves 5% i kunstneraftift af hammerslagsprisen med tillæg af auktionsmokstninger på 24% excl. moms på værker af alle nyere danske og de fleste udenlandske kunstnere. Disse værker er mærket ^{CD} for Copy-Dan ud for katalognummeret.
